JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Arrive to work dressed properly with appropriate uniform
- Takes ownership of schedule by ensuring appropriate coverage; securing substitutes when necessary, and substituting for others when needed
- Surveillance of patrons in the pool and on the pool deck
- Preventive maintenance as necessary to prevent injuries by minimizing or eliminating hazardous situations or behaviors
- Recognize emergencies and react accordingly, utilizing rescue skills, first aid and CPR as necessary
- Follow and enforce policies and procedures of the Kenosha YMCA, and educate patrons as needed
- Project yourself with an aura of authority while maintaining a positive image through tact and genuine concern for the pool users
- Greet members and participants in a friendly manner but limit conversation to concentrate on observing the pool area for safety

KEY QUALIFICATIONS

- 16 years old with valid Work Permit
- Current certification in Red Cross Lifeguard, First Aid & CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer Preferred
- 0-6 months experience
- Ability to control up to 30 people in a pool environment
- Ability to work independently and stay alert
- Ability to resolve issues in professional manner.
- Knowledge and application of lifeguarding surveillance and rescue techniques
- Leadership and public relations skills
- Decision-making skills
- Background check cannot contain offenses restricted by state law for individuals over 18yrs.
