Position: Water Safety Instructor

General Description: Responsible for planning, coordinating and teaching Parent and Child Aquatics, Preschool Aquatics, Learn-to-Swim, and Water Safety courses and presentations.

Minimum Qualifications:

Current certification in the following:

- American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor
- 16-years-of-age with valid work permit

Preferred certification in the following:

- American Red Cross CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer
- American Red Cross First Aid Certification

Pre-employment testing of WSI knowledge and skills

Knowledge and Skills:

- Thorough knowledge and application of swimming and water safety skills
- Thorough knowledge and application of teaching swimming and water safety skills
- An understanding of facility characteristics, rules, policies, and procedures
- Leadership and public relation skills
- Communication skills
- Decision-making skills

Responsibilities:

- Be familiar with American Red Cross Parent and Child Aquatics, Preschool Aquatics and Learn-to-Swim levels and other Red Cross water safety courses and presentations, and know how to use course materials effectively
- Adapt your teaching approaches to the ages, experiences and abilities of participants so they can meet course objectives
- Provide for the health and safety of participants, including ensuring that all teaching and practice areas are free of hazards, and that materials and equipment are safe
- Cover all materials required in a level
- Communicate regularly with participants and their parents, as appropriate, to ensure they are aware of progress.
- Takes ownership of class schedule by ensuring appropriate class coverage; securing substitutes when necessary, and substituting for others when needed
- Recognize and respond effectively in emergencies in accordance with facility emergency action plans
- Enforce all aquatic facility policies, rules, and regulations
- Complete records and reports
- Maintain current certifications and consistently participate in regular in-service trainings and meetings
- Reads and responds to system and departmental emails and phone calls in a timely manner.
- Complete additional duties as assigned by supervisor
