The BASE Teacher shall assist in planning, implementing, supervising & evaluating recreational and academic activities daily to provide adventure, enjoyment, academic support, and develop social skills and interests in youth.

- Responsible for the health and safety of children in the program
- Maintain a professional attitude and relationship with parents
- Build healthy, nurturing relationships with the children, and help them connect to one another
- Attend staff meetings
